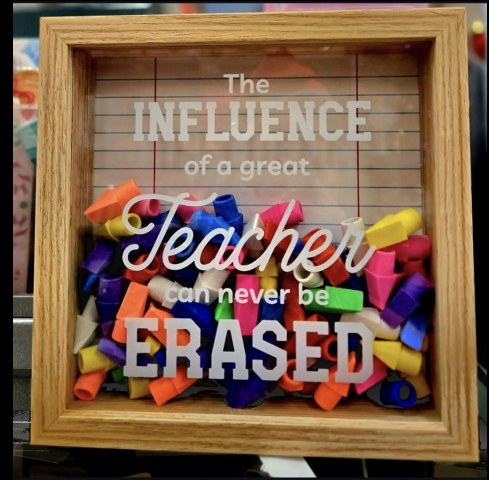


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Why I Teach

"Every child carries a spark of brilliance. My mission is to protect it and help it grow."

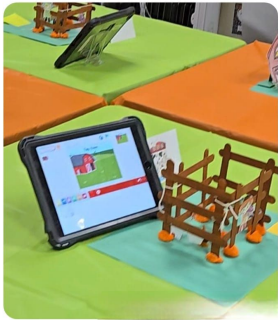
